Being able to send messages and documents between computers is really helpful

In school we do this by:


- sending e-mail, sometimes with attachments
- using Teams
- sharing documents through OneDrive

E-mail is one way to send messages and documents between computers (text message is another)

An **attachment** is a document that you send with the e-mail - it could be a PowerPoint document or an image

E-mail is:

- quick messages get there almost straight away
- lets you share documents easily
- can be used to send messages to lots of people at once
- is fairly easy to use
- can be misused


True. There are all sorts of problems with e-mail

Spam is e-mail that is sent to people to try to get them to buy something (a bit like leaflets you might get through your door)

These days it's often picked up by e-mail systems using Spam filters and you might never see it

The best advice witH Spam is to ignore it

Some Spam can be dangerous




This is an example of a **Phishing e-mail**. It looks like I might need to click link in the e-mail and enter my details

If I do, whoever sent the e-mail will know my log in details

Other spam e-mails might include documents to download

If I download them, my computer could be infected with a computer virus or other problem





This e-mail is trying to find out more about me

That gives people information that they could use to guess my passwords
