

Quiz skills - broadcast

One problem with your quiz is that it gets pretty long.

There are lots of questions and they all do the same sort of thing

In particular, the “if you go it righ...” sets of blocks keep doing almost exactly the same thing

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There's a way to make the quiz shorter

This uses an idea called broadcasts

The screenshot on slide 3 shows you how to do this

Slide 4 explains how it works



Main program



```
when clicked
ask What is 2 + 2 and wait
set rightAnswer to 4
broadcast checkAnswer
ask Question 2 etc... and wait
set rightAnswer to ???
broadcast checkAnswer
```

Broadcast



```
when I receive checkAnswer
if answer = rightAnswer then
say That's correct for 2 seconds
change score by 1
else
say That's not right for 2 seconds
say join The right answer was rightAnswer for 2 seconds
```

IMPORTANT:
This main program is not complete - it doesn't set the score to 0 or do the introduction, for example

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A broadcast is a **subroutine**

This takes a part of the program that you need to do lots of times in pretty much the same way and breaks it into its own, separate program

This means your main program can be much shorter

You have to set the **rightAnswer variable** each time so that you can check it in the broadcast
