## Working with shapes - warped shapes

## Setup

1. File > New to create a new Artboard. Make it 200mm by 200mm
2. Click View $>$ Show Grid (at bottom)

## Drawing a basic circle

3. Click and hold on the Rectangle Tool on the left toolbar > choose the Ellipse Tool
4. Hold down SHIFT and draw a perfect circle. Fill about half of the artboard. Make the fill colour lime green and the stroke transparent


## Centre the circle

5. On the left toolbar, switch to the Selection Tool at the top and select the circle
6. On the right sidebar, click the two centre buttons

## Warp the circle

7. Take a look at the circle. You should see that there are four anchor points - small blue boxes. We can use these to warp the shape

8. IMPORTANT: On the left toolbar switch to the Direct Selection Tool (white arrow). This is the tool to use for warping
9. Click once on one of the anchor points. It should change to have a solid blue centre. If it doesn' $\dagger$ change, click on it again
10. Click on the anchor point again and drag it to warp the shape. Aim for the sort of shape shown
 in the screenshot
11. Save your work and then export it as a PNG file (File > Export > Export As)
